This is Australia's oldest surviving homestead. It was built
by John Macarthur in 1793.
Admission cost: Adult \$8.00, Concession \$4.00

- 11.15am – *Experiment Farm*, 9 Ruse St., Harris Park.**
This is the site of the first land grant in Australia.
Gov Phillip granted this land to James Ruse in 1789.
Admission cost: Adult \$7.00, Concession \$5.00
National Trust Members free
- 12.30pm – Lunch at Parramatta Workers Club, 163 George Street,
Harris Park or BYO picnic on riverside opposite the Club**
- 2.00pm - *Hambledon Cottage*, 63 Hassall St., Harris Park, (cnr
Gregory Place). This house was built in 1824 for Penelope
Lucas, who was the Governess to John & Elizabeth
Macarthur's 3 daughters**
